CSHET membership is open to any individual who provides health education and/or training.

Membership shall be available to those individuals who are engaged in healthcare education, consultation and/or training and development of healthcare personnel, patients or communities.

Membership in the society shall be terminated automatically at the end of a membership year if annual dues are not paid. The membership year is January 1 through December 31.

If a new member joins in the 4th quarter of a fiscal year, their membership will be for a 15 month period of time, October of that year – December 31 of the next year.

Members are granted the right to vote on questions of official business which are before the Society and shall be allowed to hold office within the Society.

Membership in the Society shall become official when a formal written application has been completed, dues have been submitted, and the Secretary of the Society validates the applicant's classification. Past Presidents of the Society, who are still active in the field, hold membership status free of charge for a period of five years?

The current membership listing is created by the Treasurer and is archived by the Secretary of the Society. Members who have a change of position, membership status or address, are required to notify the Secretary in writing or by email.
