By a majority vote of those present and voting at any regular or special meeting the Society may order a general referendum upon any question pending before it. If the number of regular members voting at an annual meeting constitutes less than 25 percent of the regular Society members, a mail or email referendum shall be conducted to determine the final vote and a plurality of ballots shall determine the action taken.

Regular members of the Carolina Society of Healthcare Education and Training are allowed to vote on issues presented by the Society. Voting may be conducted at any business meeting, by mail or email. Members will be provided with adequate information and time to encourage questions or discussion prior to the final vote.
